*Originally, I wasn't too excited about soybeans. It didn't make sense to grow them without the heat units or the yield. Now, however, because of better genetics and yields it does make sense and it is beneficial to have soybeans in our rotation. Soybeans are an alternative oilseed crop that help us break up disease cycles, spread out our harvest, and are easily marketable because of very few quality discounts.*

On NSGM seed varieties;

*We have had good experiences with NorthStar Genetics Manitoba soybeans. The pods seem to be consistently higher off the ground, and if you can harvest a mile or two faster, that is worth a lot to me. The Warren variety is tailored to a lower heat unit climate and has done very well for us in the last couple of very wet years.*
